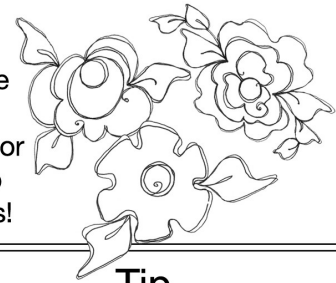


Fun Flowers

Large, simple bold blooms make the perfect embellishment for accessories, apparel, home decor and bridal. Custom color key to outfits, accessories and projects!



Instruction	Materials	Tip
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Choose design and fabrics 2. Print PDF/Applique pattern actual size 3. Hoop 2 layers of net 4. Stitch out placement stitch Do not remove from hoop 5. Spray starch or fusible web fabrics 6. Cut paper pattern pieces apart leaving 1/2" margins, pin or press to fabrics 7. Using paper pattern, cut out fabrics, place inside placement stitch, pin with tiny pins or needles or fuse to net 8. Optional: spray pieces with spray fabric adhesive. Sprinkle with sequins sparingly 9. Overlay with tulle, pin in corners, away from stitching 10. Stitch outline stitch 11. Remove from hoop, remove pins, cut out very close to stitching 12. Layer up layers or ruffle petals depending on flower style 13. Assemble 14. Add ribbon, pipe cleaner tendrils, beaded yo-yo center, buttons, etc 	<p>apparel, fancy or quilt fabrics all work well pdf</p> <p>petticoat net (This is the finer type)</p> <p>spray starch or fusible web</p> <p>pdf</p> <p>scissors</p> <p>Sulky KK 2000 sequins</p> <p>tulle, pins</p>	<p>Think about net and tulle background and overlay colors and thread color and type (i.e. metallic, variegated, etc.) 12' x 18' precut net and tulle folded in two works well. Is easier to handle and ready to go.</p> <p>Make stiff like paper. Suggest having dedicated iron for fusing and starch!</p> <p>Use favorite small cutting scissors.</p> <p>Sequins lightly applied will go under sewing machine needle fine. Will go flat when pressed. adds a real nice sparkling touch.</p> <p>Cut out first with 1/2" margin then very close to stitching. Place copy paper behind, cut together Run petals through a ruffler for tiny, flat pleats or string together by hand.</p> <p>**Quarter Stitch! This is a great little technique for adding dimension to your fun flowers. Fold finished bottom layer in quarters. Make a 1/16" stitch across point of fold to confine fabric at point. When opened up and manipulated a little this will create a fun bounce to your base!</p>

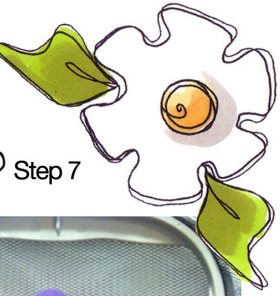

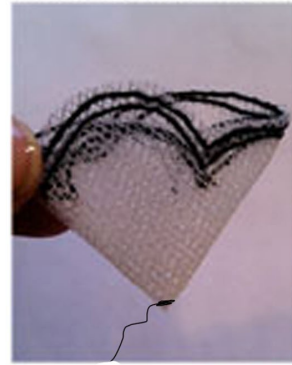
